

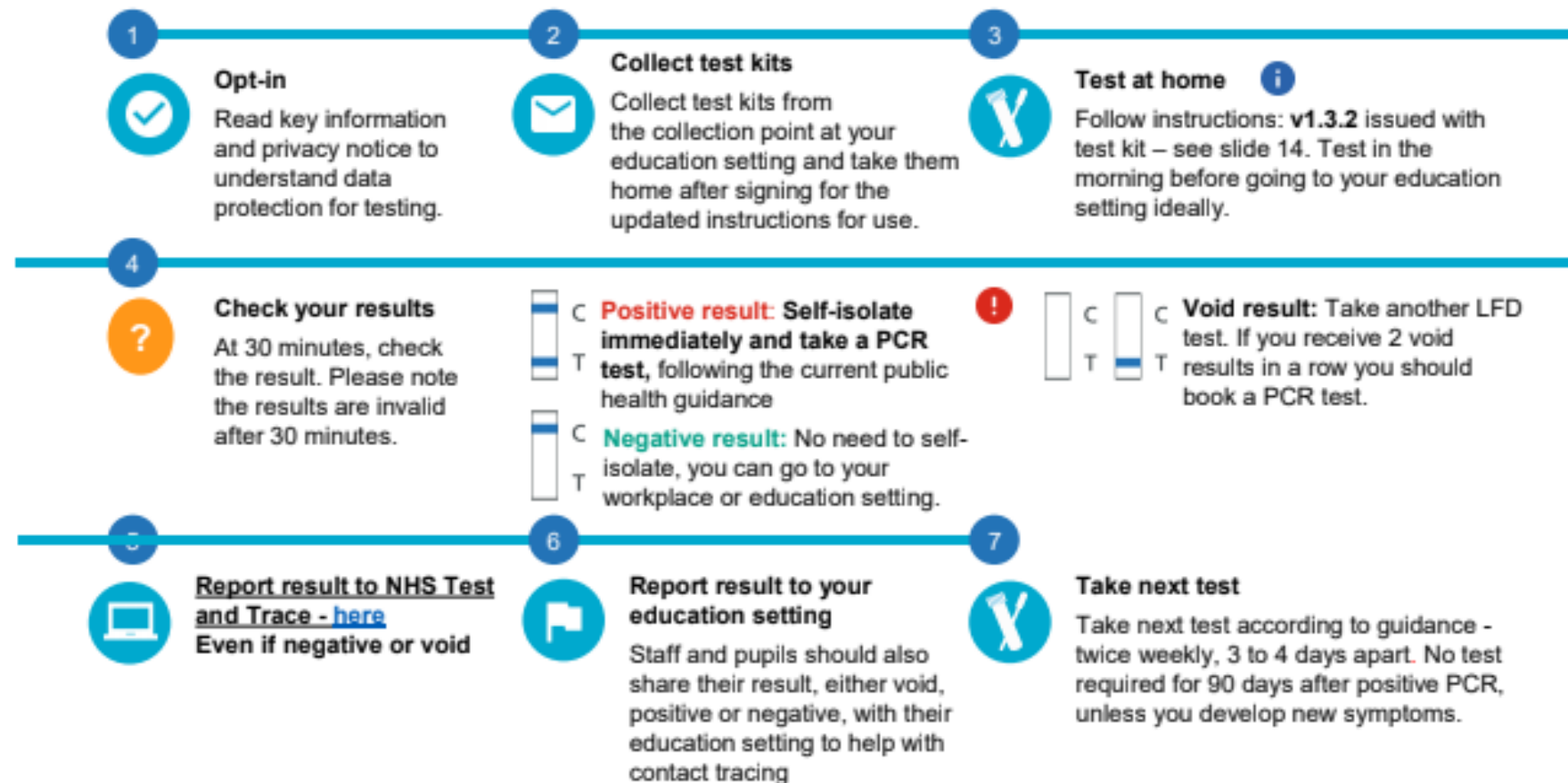

Testing at home – the process



When to Test?

It is recommended that you test yourself in the morning before attending school (so there is less chance you get infected between taking the test and attending the setting). However, you may choose to do the testing the evening before, especially the first time, to give you more time to get used to the test.

John Roan test days will be Monday & Thursday

What if I test positive?

If you receive a positive LFD result you should book a confirmatory PCR test. We would advise visiting a community or drive through test site as this is the quickest way to get tested, or you can order a home test kit. It is important that you self-isolate until the result of your PCR test.

What is in my home testing kit?

In your pack you will have:

- Enough kits for 3 home tests
- Swabs (3)
- Extraction fluid (3)
- Testing vials (3)
- Testing cartridge (3)
- Waste bags (3)

PLEASE NOTE: We have been advised by the DofE and PHE that the instruction booklet within the pack has outdated guidance and should not be used. You will be provided with a separate, up to date, instruction booklet when you collect your test kits.

Participation and Data Protection

All participation in testing is voluntary

Once you have understand the testing process and have read the privacy notice, if you choose to participate you are committing to self-administer the test and report your results via the NHS Test & Trace digital platform and to your education setting.

Before taking your test, you must do three things:

1. Read the **privacy notice** to understand what will happen with your data.
2. Take a copy of the new **Instructions for Use** v1.3.2 and ensure it is the correct version
3. Record your details in the Test Kit Log (see following slide for details)



People who decline to participate in this testing programme should follow the usual national guidelines on self-isolation and [get tested](#) if they show symptoms.

Collecting your test kit

Test kits and guidance booklets will be given to you by your form tutor on Friday morning. You will need to sign that you have taken a test kit. Each kit has a batch number which is recorded.

Reporting your test result

- You are **required to report the results** of your tests online, or by phone, every time you take a test, even if the result was negative or void. You must report your results: <https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result>

The school does not have access to the online results
reported by students.

- Schools are expected to keep their own records of student results. All parents will need to record their child's result via the attached link:

- If you have a positive result you must inform school ASAP via the normal absence procedures.
